80/154 #1	Ryder House at 4th & Wood St. February 1937. Photo taken during full moon.
80/154 #2	Old hospital and later library at corner of 2nd and Elliot St. Dog team in front [maybe Lloyd Ryder's aunt in sleigh and Roland Ryder -Lloyd's grandfather- at right]. Ca.1905-1920.
80/154 #3	Lloyd Ryder's Model T and Laurent Cyr's Chevrolet. Bob Richards standing beside the Model T. Laurent Cyr is not inside his car. On Main St. near Burns Building. Ca. 1935
80/154 #4	Cenotaph located on Elliot St. in front of the library at 2nd and Elliot. Ca. 1920
80/154 #5	2nd Avenue hospital on 2nd and Hanson St. Ca. 1933-34
80/154 #6	Cenotaph in front of the library. Presbyterian Church steeple on Main St. visible in background. Ca. 1920.
80/154 #7	Roland Ryder in front of Government Assay Office [also liquor store, mining recorder, licensing and other government operations] on his horse drawn water tank for delivering water around town. Corner of 2nd and Steele St. [Regina Hotel in background]. Ca. 1907.
