87/61 #1	San Francisco Examiner (July 29, 1897) p. 1, with Clarence Berry's nuggets.
87/61 #2	The larger Clarence Berry nugget.
87/61 #3	The small Clarence Berry nugget.
87/61 #4	Clarence Berry's pouch with the two nuggets on it.
87/61 #5	Yukon currency saved by Clarence or Fred Berry.
87/61 #6	A 3.5 cm. pin with the initials FCB (Fred C. Berry) and the word Yukon. These were apparently made as souvenirs.
87/61 #7	The Berry nuggets on the Canadian miner's permit of Stewart Campbell of Kalamazoo, Mich.
87/61 #8	The San Francisco Examiner, July 29, 1897, page 1. The gold nuggets were collected by Clarence Berry probably at Bonanza Creek. The larger nugget is 2.25" by 1.5" by .25" thick (6cm x 4 cm x 0.63cm). It was recently appraised at \$10,000. The smaller is 7/8" by 3/4" (2.3cm x 2.0cm). The 3.5cm pin with the initials FCB (Fred C. Berry) and the word Yukon. This was apparently made as a souvenir.
