90/28 #1	1-S	Fritz Guder's old cabin, fall 1963 - Mt. Freegold near Carmacks.
90/28 #2	2-S	Another view of Fritz Guder's cabin and cache on Seymour Creek, fall 1963 - Mt. Freegold near Carmacks.
90/28 #3	3-S	Interior view of Fritz Guder's cabin, fall 1963 - Mt. Freegold near Carmacks.
90/28 #4	4-S	Another view of interior of Fritz Guder's cabin, fall 1963 - Mt. Freegold near Carmacks.

90/28 #6	6-S	Fritz Guder and visitor Col. Frank E. Noyes outside of Guder Cabin, fall 1963 - Mt. Freegold near Carmacks. Added information from Mr. Bee: Col. Noyes traveled with A.E. Bee on our visit to the Yukon in 1963.
90/28 #7	7-S	Old prospector cabins - abandoned, fall 1963 - Mt. Freegold near Carmacks. Added information from Mr. Bee: There was a lot of prospecting activity and exploration at Mt. Freegold in the 1930's and these are left over from that period.
90/28 #8	8-S	Old prospector cabins - abandoned, fall 1963 - Mt. Freegold near Carmacks. Added information from Mr. Bee: There was a lot of prospecting activity and exploration at Mt. Freegold in the 1930's and these are left over from that period.
90/28 #9	9-S	Diamond drilling setup - top of Mt. Freegold, fall 1963 - Mt. Freegold near Carmacks. Added information from Mr. Bee: In 1963 there was a company - name forgotten - that had, I believe, taken an option on the LAFORMA properties and were drilling to try to establish a viable ore body.

90/28 #10	10-S	A.E. Bee and Mr. & Mrs. Goulter at home of the Goulters in Carmacks, fall 1963 - Carmacks. Added information from Mr. Bee: Goulters [were] very long time residents of Carmacks at that time. A.E. Bee knew the family as a child and in 1933-34. Lois Back Bee [was] a long time close friend of Mrs. Goulter.	
90/28 #11	11-S	Mr. Frank Goulter in front of Carmacks home, fall 1963 - Carmacks.	
90/28 #12	12-S	Visitor Col. Frank E. Noyes and Mr. and Mrs. Goulter in front of Goulter Carmacks home, fall 1963 - Carmacks.	
90/28 #13	13-S	A.E. Bee and I am almost positive this is Bill Langham (in red shirt) whom I knew in the 1930's, fall 1963 - Carmacks. Added information from Mr. Bee: Bill Langham was one of the prospectors at Mt. Freegold who had put together the LAFORMA group of claims and, in the 1930's, these claims had first been optioned to the Timmins Corp. who did extensive exploration but did not proceed. Other companies seem still to be doing exploration work on these claims even today.

90/28 #14	14-S	Postmistress - (name forgotten) [Vera Liden]. In 1963 the Carmacks Post Office was in this small cabin next to the old barn and across the road from the old Carmacks Roadhouse next to the Nordenskold River, fall 1963 - Carmacks. Added information from Mr. Bee: Apparently the Carmacks post office has been moved around a good deal over the years.
90/28 #15	15-S	Bill Langham and Carmacks Postmistress (name forgotten) showing off her carrots raised in a garden across the road from the post office (see #14), fall 1963 - Carmacks.
90/28 #16	16-S	Another shot of the Carmacks Postmistress - (name forgotten) - with her dog. Post Office in background and also old barn used with the Carmacks Roadhouse, fall 1963 - Carmacks.
90/28 #17	17-S	Another shot of the old Carmacks Roadhouse next to the Nordenskiold [Nordenskiold] River. This was a two story building originally, fall 1963 - Carmacks.

90/28 #18	18-S	Carmacks diesel electrical generating plant in 1963, - Carmacks. Added information from Mr. Bee: I don't know the history when this plant was installed and when it was removed and power lines run from Whitehorse or (?) which seemed to be the situation in 1989.
90/28 #19	19-S	R.C.M.P. building at Carmacks, fall 1963 - Carmacks. Added information from Mr. Bee: Have no data on when this was built. The building I remember from the 1930's was of logs.
90/28 #20	20-S	Entrance road and sign, fall 1963 - Carmacks. Added information from Mr. Bee: Road was not paved in 1963.
90/28 #21	21-S	Carmacks Hotel - Tantalus Butte in background, fall 1963 - Carmacks. Added information from Mr. Bee: As I recall in 1963 one of the owners was one of the original Van Bibber girls.

90/28 #22	22-S	Bee camper/truck in front of Tom Bee's original log trading post next to the River. In 1963 this building was being used for the community centre. Gone in 1989. Built in 1916 or thereabouts, fall 1963 - Carmacks.
90/28 #23	23-S	Col. Frank E. Noyes and camper (visitors) in front of Tom Bee's trading post building, fall 1963 - Carmacks. See #22 for more details
90/28 #24	24-S	Former home of Howard and Alice McMillan. Also was the Post Office, telegraph office and mine recording office, fall 1963 - Carmacks. Added information from Mr. Bee: You have black and white photos of this building I supplied with some historical data. [See PHO 389, 90/19 #177]
90/28 #25	25-S	New School buildings under construction, fall 1963 - Carmacks. Added information from Mr. Bee: I visited the Carmacks school in 1989. A big addition to the buildings in this photo. A very attractive total school facility. As a child in Carmacks I took correspondence courses. There were very few white children at that time and almost no native children.
