92/34 #1	Frank Sketch at Kloo Lake.
92/34 #2	Gudrun Erickson, left, and Jim Boss in front of the Regina Hotel - ca. 1938.
92/34 #3	Trucks were not an unknown quantity prior to the Alaska Highway. Karl Bryden on back. Man barely seen is Sam Magee. Driver might be Carl Strandberg.
92/34 #4	Looking toward the Yukon River. Gudrun Sparling in foreground.
92/34 #5	Drastic fire burns down the Northern Commercial store on First Avenue. Note Taylor and Drury store at left. (Sparling Photo)
92/34 #6	Children of famous Yukon pilot Everett Wasson, Barbara and John at right, John Erickson, now proprietor of the Regina Hotel, at left. Background is old Taylor and Drury store and gas pump house at left and middle, and Northern Commercial store at right.
92/34 #7	Approximate location of the current museum, a Yukoner takes aim at a north country mosquito.
92/34 #8	One of Whitehorse city's older buildings may still be seen at the corner of 1st and Jarvis. Persons unknown, but one may be W.W. Oskey, Tucson, Arizona.

92/34 #19	Queen Viola Sullivan of Skagway and friends at the first Whitehorse winter carnival in 1945.
92/34 #20	Group poses in front of the John Rose home at left and the Ryder home at right L to R: Gudrun Erickson, Gladys Wilson, Babe Richards, ? , Helen Cameron, Audrey Ryder, and Lilly Cyr.
