93/72R #1	Bottom of staff on North side Piece [Peace] River Bridge. July 1943.
93/72R #2	B.C. Ferry pusher and flat bottom ferry on Piece [Peace] River, 1943.
93/72R #3	Pretty Falls. Mile 640 N. Fort Nelson (into Watson Lake). [1943].
93/72R #4	West of Mile 8. July 2, 1943. [Two men trying to recover overturned truck on the Alaska Highway].
93/72R #5	Army Huts. 640 N. [Army huts at Mile 640 N on the Alaska Highway, 1943].
93/72R #6	Another dynamite blast of jammed logs, Liard River. Temporary bridge. [Alaska Highway, 1943].
93/72R #7	U.S. Army Camp, Liard Mt., 1943.
93/72R #8	Trucks loaded with building material. [Alaska Highway, 1943]
93/72R #9	Truck stuck. 1943. Alaska Highway. Bill came in 2nd best.
93/72R #10	Sickney River Bridge. On Highway North. [1943].
93/72R #11	Mile 67. Bridge rebuilding. [Alaska Highway, 1943].
93/72R #12	This is a copy of a post card. Taken along the line of the CPR by Ron Harmon, Banff, Canada. CPR 1945 near Fields. Same train.

93/72R #15	Geo. W. Woods took picture of truck overturned in mill creek of bridge. Alaska Highway, 1943. 500 miles north of Dawson Creek. Fell about 20 ft. near camp at mile 67 N.

93/72R #17	Curran and Briggs Camp, Mile 67. [Alaska Highway, 1943].
93/72R #18	Muskwa B.C. Bridge. Steel and cement about 1200 ft. long. Close to Port [Fort?] Nelson, B.C. 1943
93/72R #19	Driving piles at Mile 67, 1943. Bridge washed out July 10-43.
93/72R #20	A farm four miles from Whitehorse. [1943].
93/72R #21	North of P.R. Bridge. Taken across River, May 1943. Piece [Peace] River in rampage travelling about 30 miles per hour. Geo. Woods.
93/72R #22	The Mighty Piece [Peace] River about 2000 ft. across at high water level with the banks. [1943].
