96/11 #1	Second Catholic Church in Dawson - St. Mary's, in the north end of town. The hospital is visible to the left. Father Joe Allard, OMI on the right; Father Joseph Schuster, vicar, on the left. Souvenir [picture] of the Little Ones First Communion, St. Mary's Catholic Church, Pentecost Sunday, June 4th, 1911, Dawson [City] Yukon Territory Canada
96/11 #2	Emile Brunoze became First Bishop of Rupert's Land and was responsible for this area. L to R - Joseph Allard and Joseph Schuster in the back, Emile Brunoze and Father Connolly from England in the front.
96/11 #3	Rectory in Dawson City, July 1915.
96/11 #4	Interior of St Mary's Church II set up for memorial service for Pope Leo XIII with his tiara atop the casket. Father Judge's headstone is to the left.
96/11 #5	Close-up of the altar rail, paintings and nativity scene, pre-1923. 1923 was when the church was torn down.
