98/73 #1	Sikanni River Alcan Highway [A postcard depicting the snow covered Sikanni Chief River, B.C. An early Alaska Highway bridge crosses the river.] [Photographs 98/73 #1-#2 related to one another.] [Photograph 98/73 #1 and 99/41 #35 are the same image.]
98/73 #2	[Back of Sikanni River Alcan Highway postcard. Reads "Post Card", "Made in Canada", "Correspondence", "Address", and Velox stamp box. Addressed to Albert Bloomstrand's son "Mr. Steve Bloomstrand 216½ E 2nd St Hastings M". Message reads "Dear Son, Here is some of are road we came over its some trip Wish you kids could make this drive and see this Wild Country How are you getting along in school and hope you are minding your mother and help her all you can and be a good boy and say Hello to all for me Will be seeing you With Love Dad".]
