MSS 287	f1	<p>Elzeard Sansterre's incoming correspondence</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Dental record for Elzeard Sansterre from dentist Dr. A. Varicle's dental parlor in Dawson, Yukon. It provides the results of an examination of his teeth and list of fees for work performed. In English and French. 1905. - "Public School, Greenville, N.H." postcard. Sent to Elzeard Sansterre of Dawson City from his niece Beatrice of Greenville, New Hampshire. Handwritten note reads "I have received your postals and they are very nice indeed. Thanks you ever so much. Write more in a while.". Benjamin Franklin 1¢ stamp. Postmarked 6 Sep 1906. - "Nashua Junction Nashua N.H." postcard of train and train station and "Main Street, North of Temple, Nashua, N.H." postcard. Sent to Elzeard Sansterre from his niece Lodia Sansterre of Nashua, New Hampshire. Lodia indicates that despite her young age she remembers her uncle before he left for the Klondike, she questions if he has received her past correspondence, provides family updates (including the death of her brother Arthur), wonders when he will return, and requests him to write. Sep 1906. - "Rounding the Buoy" postcard of small sailing ship. Sent to Elzeard Sansterre from his niece Lodia Sansterre of Nashua, New Hampshire. She asks why he has not written and indicates she would be happy if he returned. 6 Dec 1906. - "The Old Well of the Uncle Sam's House, Mason, N.H." postcard. Sent to Elzeard Sansterre of Dawson City from his niece Beatrice of Greenville, New Hampshire. Handwritten note reads "I am waiting for an answer, when will I get it? We don't know if you are dead or alive.". Benjamin Franklin 1¢ stamp. Postmarked 9 Apr 1907. - "A Happy Birthday" postcard. Sent to Elzeard Sansterre of Dawson City. No message. Not dated. - "With Best Christmas Wishes" postcard. Sent to Elzeard Sansterre of Dawson City from his niece Lodia Sansterre. No message. Not dated. - "Montreal. Notre Dame De Lourdes" postcard of church. Sent to Elzeard Sansterre from his sister Delias. She inquires as to his health, plans for winter, and for a letter. The handwritten note reads "Comment es tu de ta sante et que 	1905-1908, n.d.

Sent to Elzeard Sansterre from his niece Beatrice. Handwritten note reads "Dear uncle, Are you dead or alive. I guess it is the latter. We haven't received news for such a long time. We are all feeling very nicely, and hope you are in perfect health also. Beatrice". Not dated.</p> <p>- Handwritten letter to Elzeard Sansterre from his goddaughter Rose de Lima Marchand of Lowell, Massachusetts. She writes of being busy with studying for school examinations, the hopes of being promoted into Grade 8, her family, and of her receipt of his postcard that she is saving. 2 Feb 1908.</p> <p>- Handwritten letter to Elzeard Sansterre from his niece Lodia Sansterre of Nashua, New Hampshire. She apologies for the pen she uses to write the letter, provides updates on her family, notes money is scarce, indicates Beatrice will become a nun, thanks him for the \$16 he sent, wishes he would visit, and requests that he tear the letter up after he reads it. 6 pages. 8 Mar 1908.</p> <p>- Handwritten letter to Elzeard Sansterre from his niece Beatrice of Greenville, New Hampshire. She thanks him for his recent letter, notes his lack of correspondence, requests a photo of him, indicates she is sending a small one of herself and photos of Florence and baby Orlando (both born after his departure), updates on local news (mills, railroad bridge), laments on the lack of employment for their relations, provides weather updates, jokes about his potential to marry, and requests him to visit. 31 Mar 1908.</p> <p>- Tag. Handwritten note reads "Bear Creek YT Effects of Elzeard Sansterre taken from Bunk House Canadian Klondyke Mining Co Limited." and stamped "May 31 1908".</p>
