MSS 562	f2	[Letter to Vera Rockliffe from Flora (Boyle) Frisch] 5 pages (onion skin, handwritten) The letter relates Frisch's current health, progress on a musical production and a play both about Joe Boyle, Joe Boyle's musical abilities, and other current topics.	7 Jun 1984
MSS 562	f3	[Letter to Vera Rockliffe from Edwin Bennett] 1 page (handwritten) + envelope The letter relates Bennett's placement of flowers at Joe Boyle's grave in Woodstock, his communication with Flora Frisch and the Taylors, upcoming plans for their trip to the Yukon, and other current topics.	18 Jul 1984
MSS 562	f4	[Letter to Vera and Len Rockliffe from Ruth and Len Taylor] 1 page (typed) The letter relates the recent trip the Taylor's experienced accompanying Flora Frisch, the Bennetts, and Flo Whyard to Dawson City. The trip included visiting Bear Creek, the Discovery Day parade, the unveiling of commemorative plaques, dredge #4, and King Solomon's Dome. MSS 562	f5	[Letter to Vera Rockliffe from Flo Whyard] 2 pages (typed and handwritten) The letter relates the recent "Royal Tour" experienced by Whyard, Flora Frisch, the Bennetts, and the Taylors around Yukon. The tour included the MacBride Museum, Yukon Archives, meeting with Yukon Government officials, a press conference, dinner at The Prospector with the Camerons, driving to Dawson City, the Gaslight Follies Show, the Dawson City Museum, the Discovery Day parade, meeting with MP Erik Nielsen, a commemorative plaque unveiling, a helicopter ride, Diamond Tooth Gertie's, St. Paul's Church service, photographs, a tour of Bear Creek provided by Parks Canada, King Solomon's Dome, Bonanza Creek and Joe Boyle's dredge #4, and a visit to the marina resort at Marsh Lake. Whyard also describes her recent travels on holiday and to visit family members, becoming a Member of the Order of Canada, Yellowknife's 50 <sup>th</sup> anniversary, assisting Erik Nielsen, her publication about pilot Ernie Boffa, and her health.	19 Sep 1984

MSS 562	f7	[Letter to Vera Rockliffe from Flora (Boyle) Frisch] 5 pages (onion skin, handwritten) + envelope The letter relates the upcoming unveiling at Joe Boyle's English grave, the lack of respect afforded Joe Boyle after his death, Queen Marie's attention to Joe Boyle's grave, the subsequent neglect of Joe Boyle's grave, Frisch's reasons for having Joe Boyle's body repatriated to Woodstock, the lack of respect from the Canadian government regarding Joe Boyle's war efforts, the upcoming musical "The Sourdough and the Queen", and other current topics.	3 Apr 1986
