Tennant of Dawson filed an assignment of the grant to H.J. Miller of Dawson of the right to mine on claim No. 6 above discovery on Victoria Gulch for one year from 8 Dec 1900. Signed by Mining Recorder. Stamped Dec 17 1900. - Reproduction of James F. Albee's receipt (No. 204) for purchase of 200 shares (\$200) of the stock of Dawson's The Lone Star Mining and Milling Co. Signed by applicant and countersigned by Acting Manager Lew Craden. Stamped Jan 21 1902. - Reproduction of Bill of Sale to Charles I. Tennant of Dawson (Free Miner's Certificate Number 36833) from Wallace W. Scott of Dawson (Free Miner's Certificate Number 37696) for the rights, titles, privileges, and interests in an undivided half of Placer Mining Claim No. 12 above discovery on All Gold Creek for the sum of \$1.00. Witnessed by T.S. McElfish. 2 pages. 2 Jul 1902. - Reproduction of H. McDonald's receipt for meat purchased (\$19.75) from Barton Bros.
