MacPherson White Horse Pharmacy label from Dr. Bolon DA to Mr. Nolan. n.d.</li> <li>- a business card from Clyde Wann's Service Stations along the Alaska Highway (Swift River, Morley River, Destruction Bay). Services include accommodations, restrooms, showers, heated garages, gas, oil, diesel, and tire service. Promotes construction of Clyde Wann's Super Service under construction at Fourth Avenue and Ogilvie Street in Whitehorse. Back of card has a poem titled "Dawson City Trail" promoting the Yukon. n.d.</li> <li>- Kiwanis Club Barrel Sweep ticket. Barrel run from Yukon dam to White Pass depot.
