| GOV 1905        | f5          | Permits to Set Out Poison #1-105<br><br>Title based on contents of file.<br>This file consists of permits issued to set out poison for predatory animals under the authority of the Yukon Game Ordinance. The permits authorized individuals to set out poison in a designated location in the Yukon for a specified time period for the purpose of poisoning wolves and coyotes. The permits were issued Jul 1924 to Feb 1926 by Inspector Edward Telford. The permits were required to be returned after expiration to the RCMP at Dawson. Many of the permits are annotated with a list of the animals killed, or if none were killed. Some of the permits still retain their detachable "Permit to Purchase Poison" (strychnine).
