This is in reply to your letter dated September 19, 1989, regarding the copyright status on the films mentoned in your letter.

For the film "Gold Rush Footage", 1901, there is no donor restriction. The duration of copyright for motion picture in Canada is a term of 50 years and in U.S.A. a term of 75 years. The footage was filmed around 1901, so we can assume that it is in public domain.

As for the title "Winds of Chance", there are no donor restrictions that we know of. The film was produced in 1925, copyrighted on July 30, 1925 and renewed on July 29, 1953 at the Library of Congress in U.S.A., which means that the film is protected by the Copyright Law in U.S.A. till July 2000. We believe that the film might be in public domain in Canada since the term here is 50 years after production. I would, however, suggest that you verify this information with Consumer and Corporate Affairs since application of the law in this case may be determined by other international conventions.
