a) LIQUOR/GOODS AND EMPTY BOTTLE & KEG TRANSPORTATION CONTRACT:

PICKING UP AND TRANSPORTING LIQUOR/GOODS FROM VANCOUVER, BRITISH COLUMBIA ON A WEEKLY BASIS. TRANSPORTATION OF EMPTY BEER BOTTLES AND KEGS FROM WHITEHORSE TO DESIGNATED DEPOTS IN VANCOUVER, BRITISH COLUMBIA.
