A seagull cried, careening in the half-light, balefully beckoning the horizon. She broke contact just as the sun touched the sea.

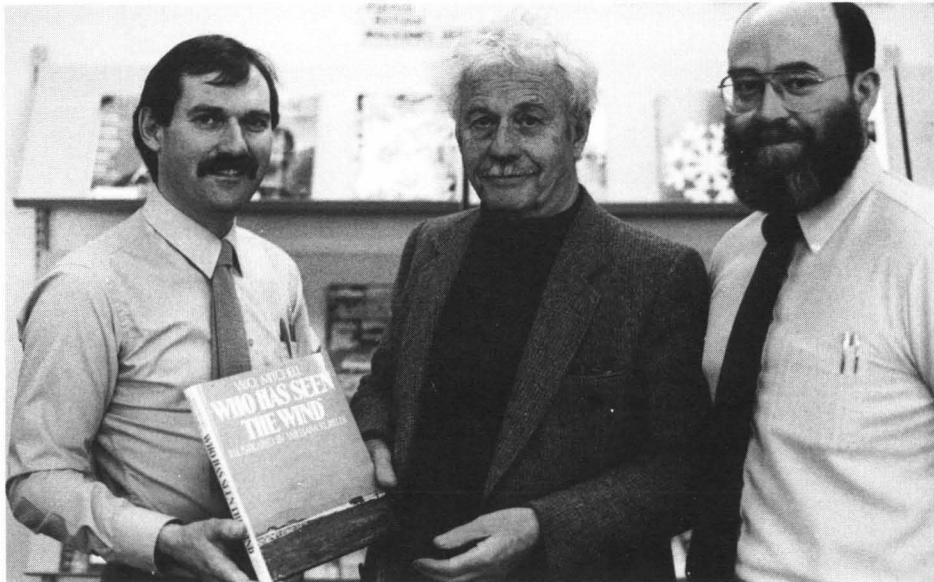

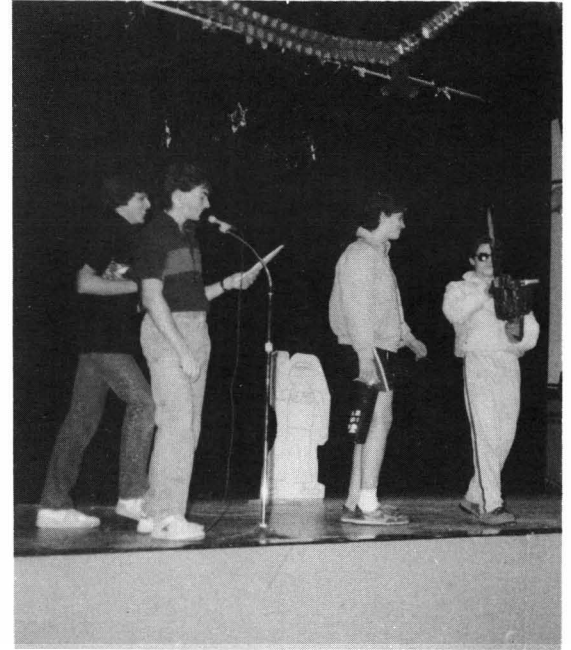
