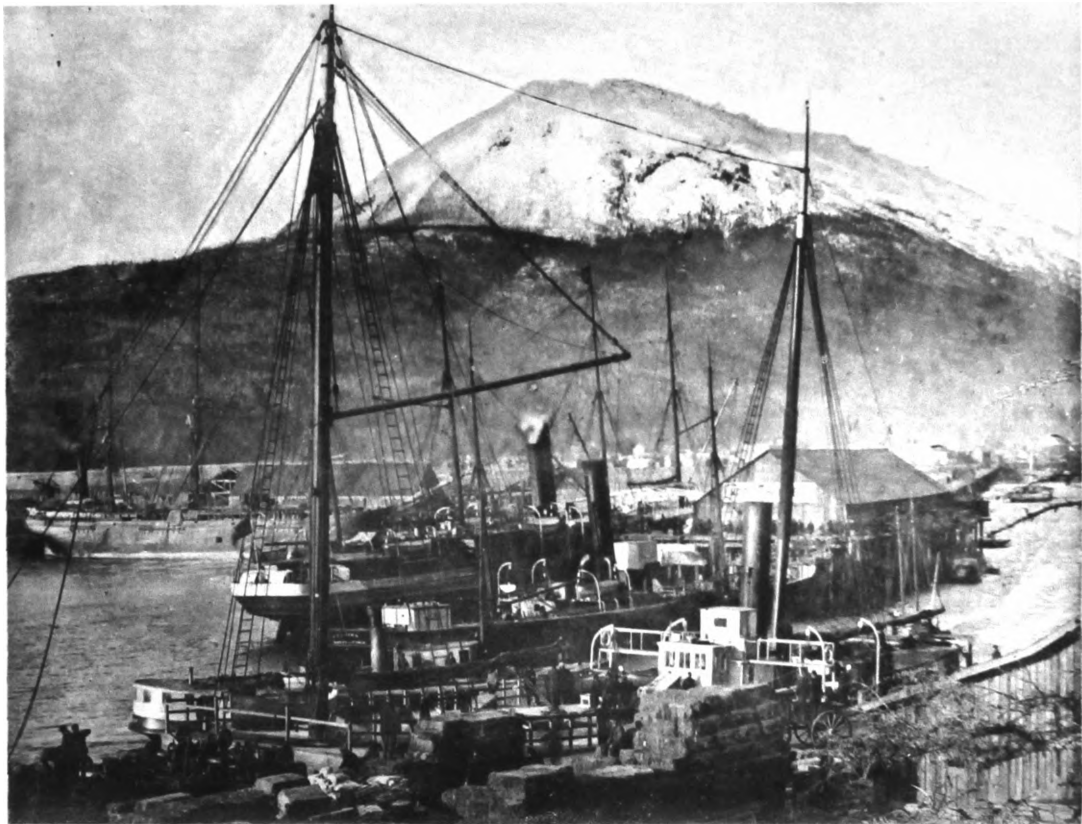

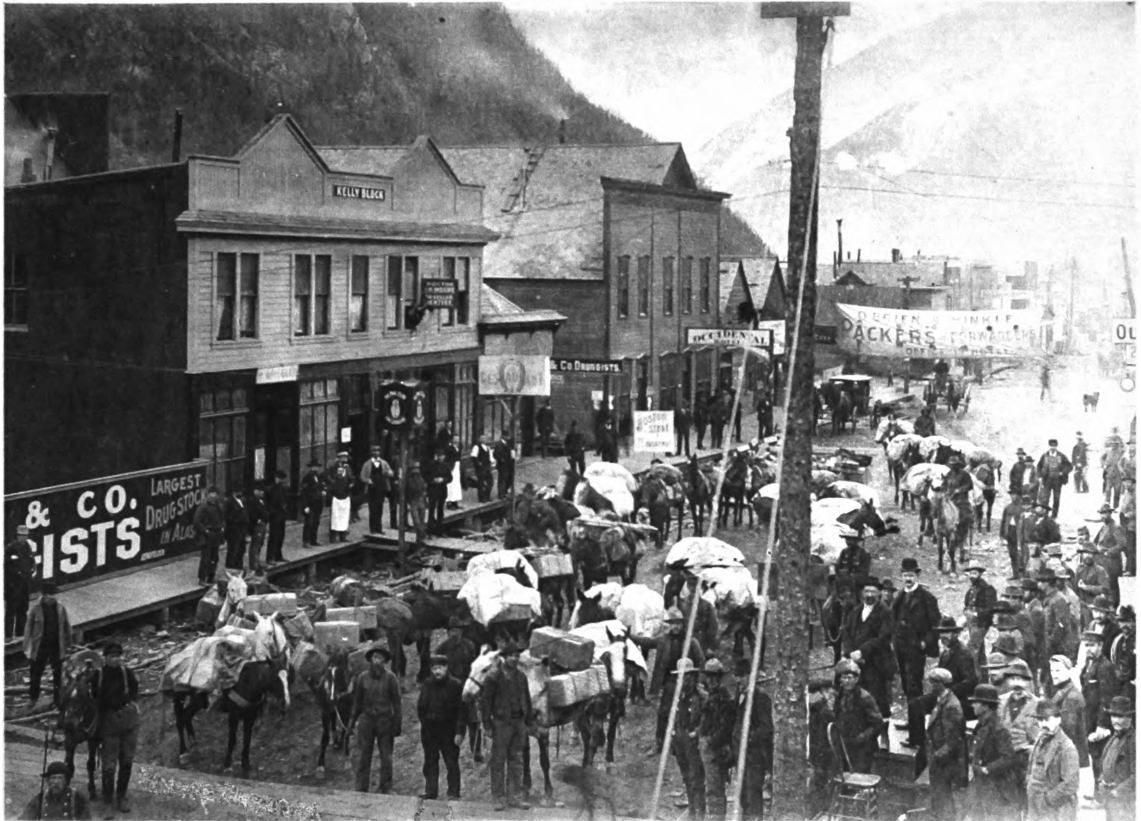

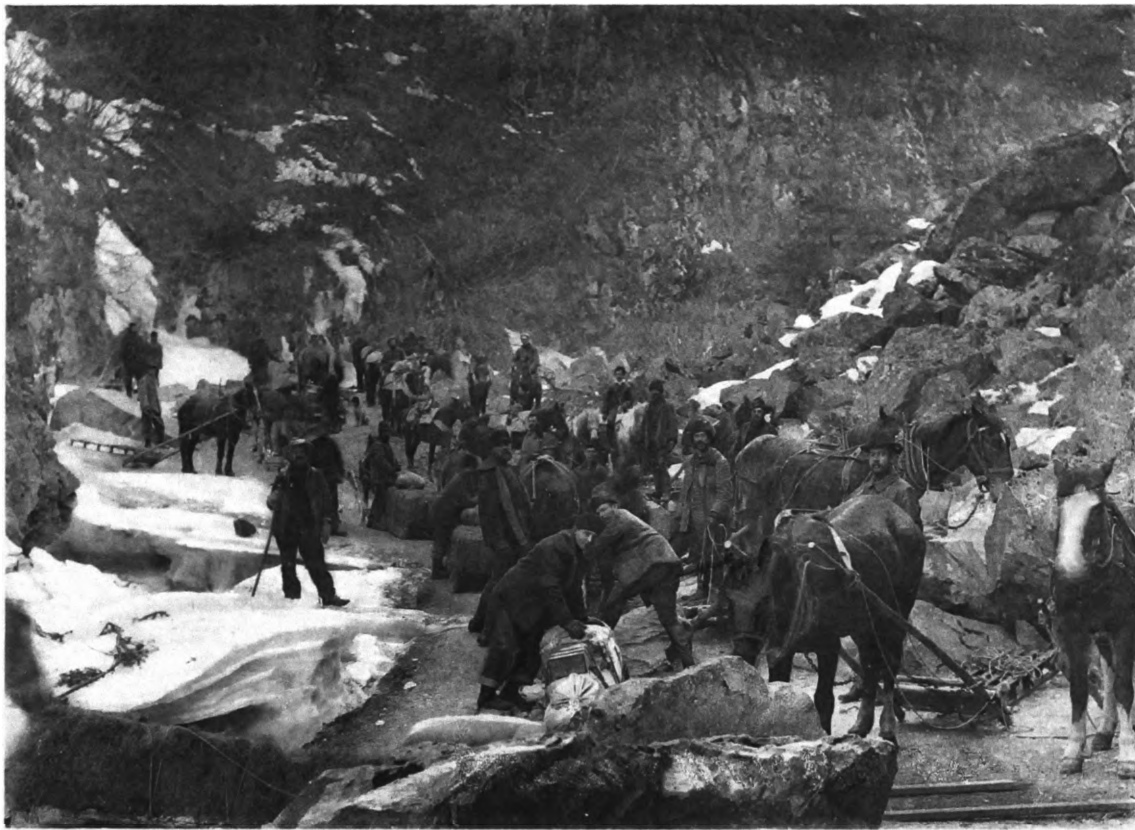

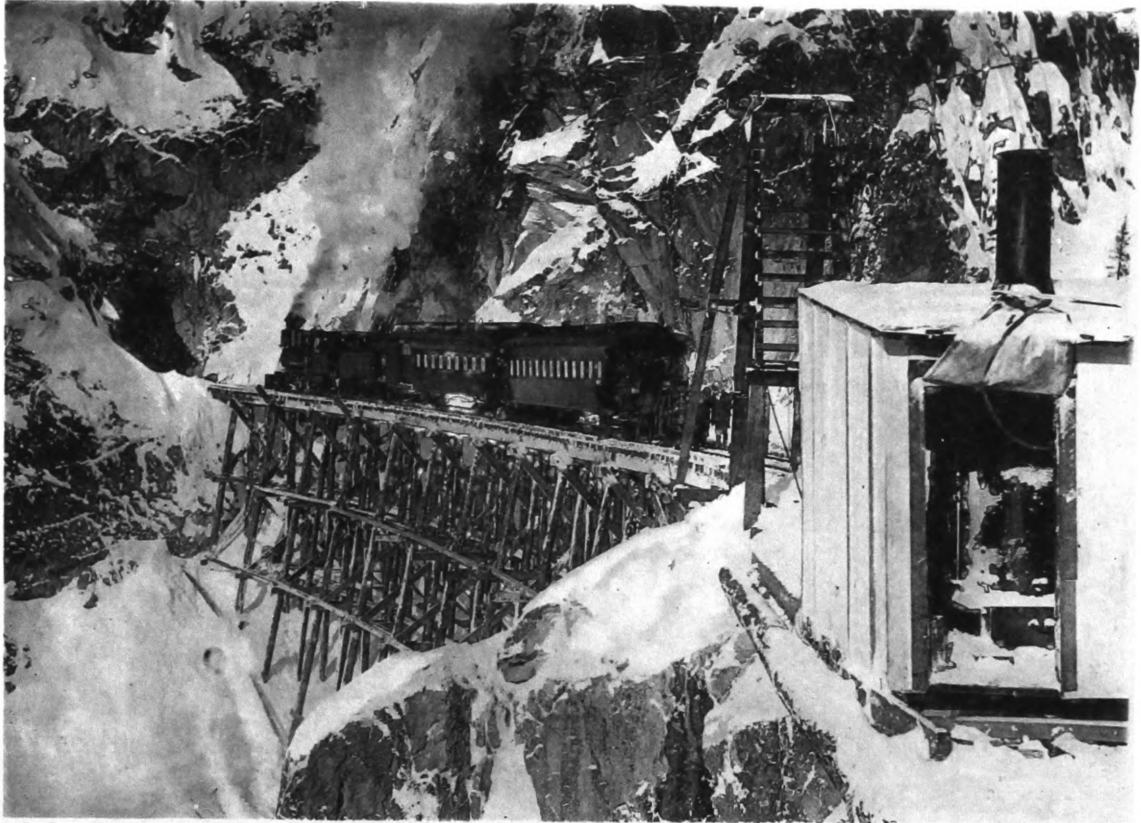

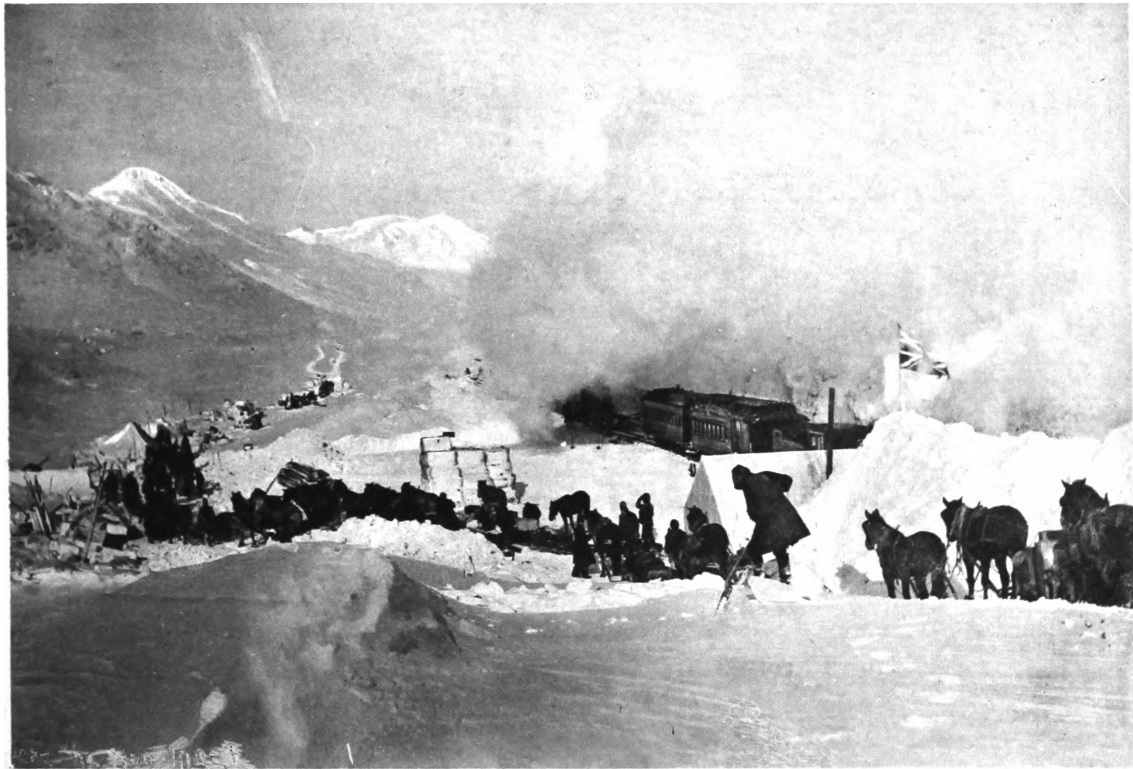

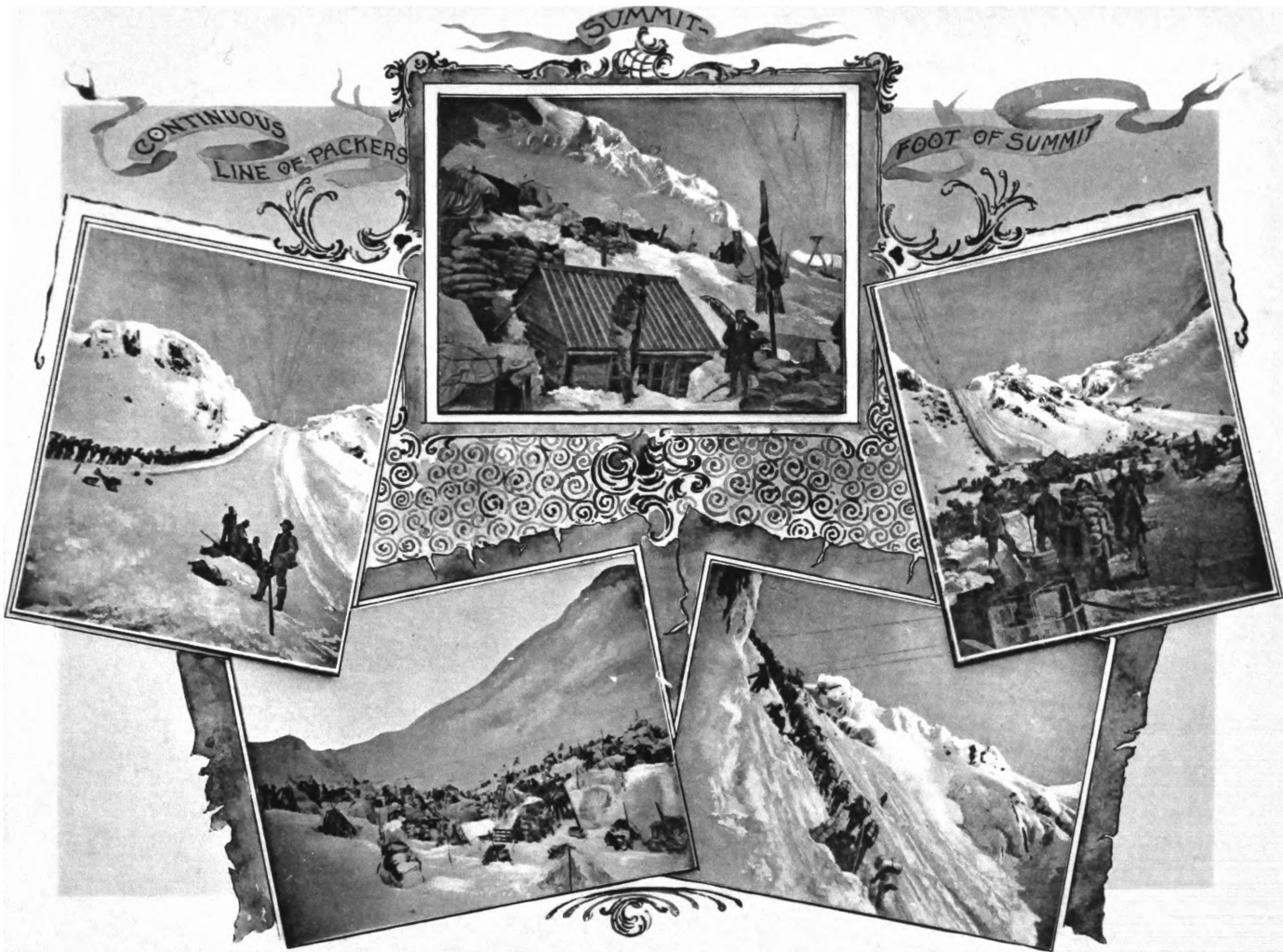

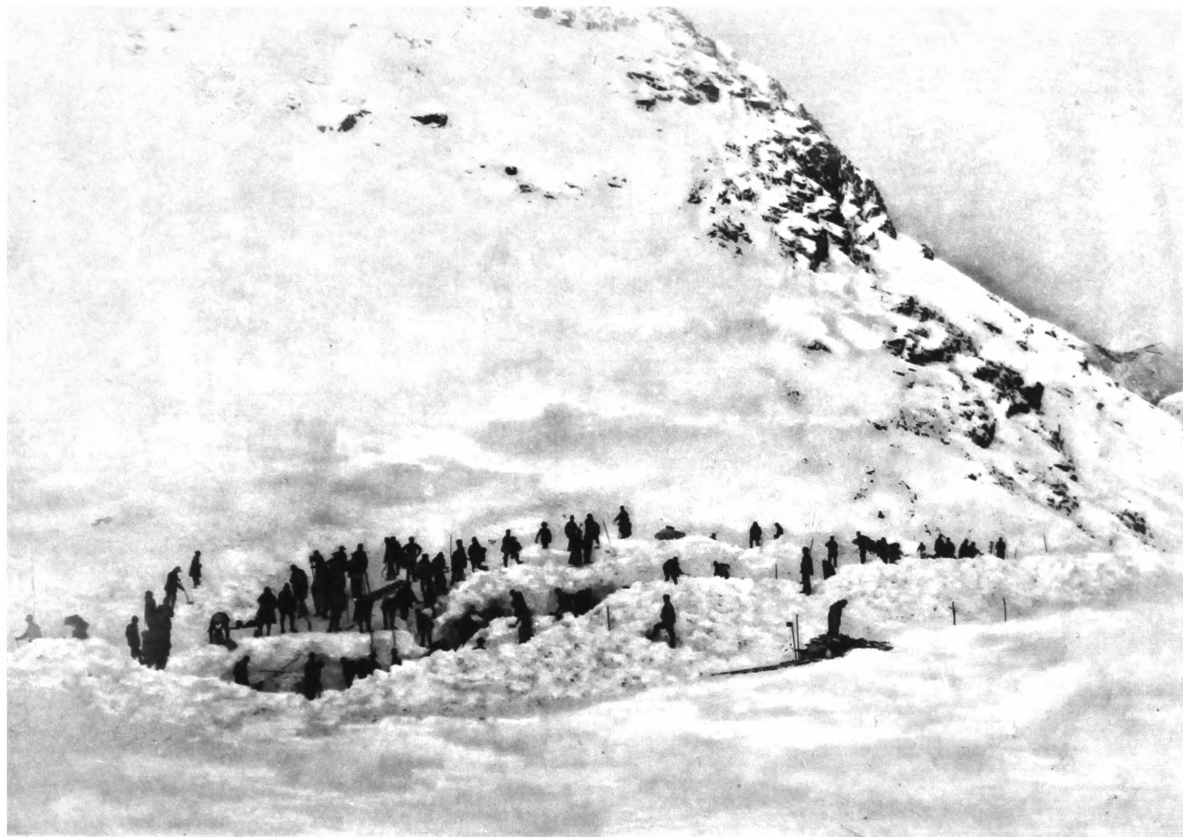

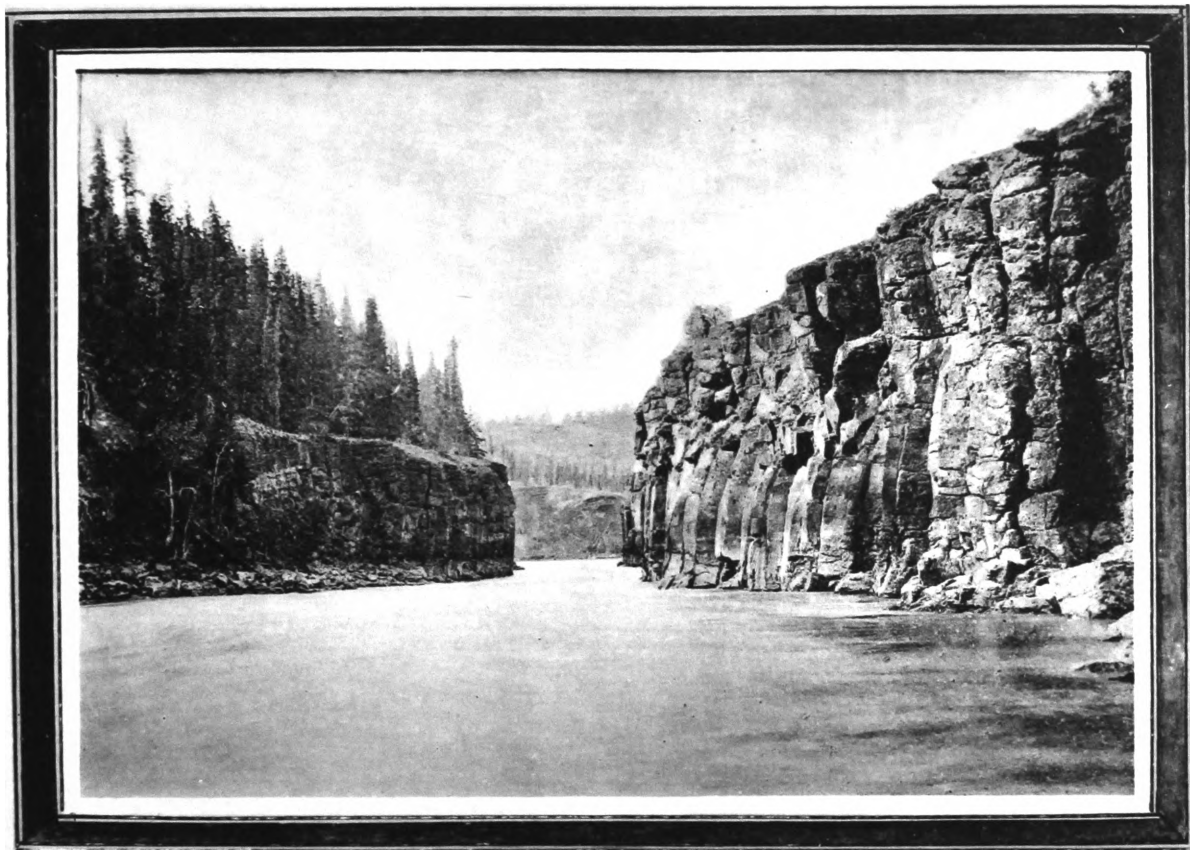

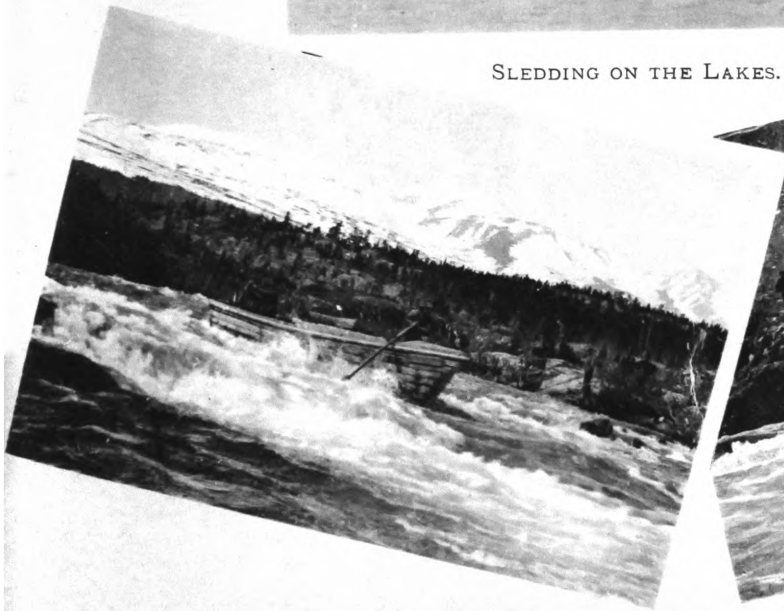

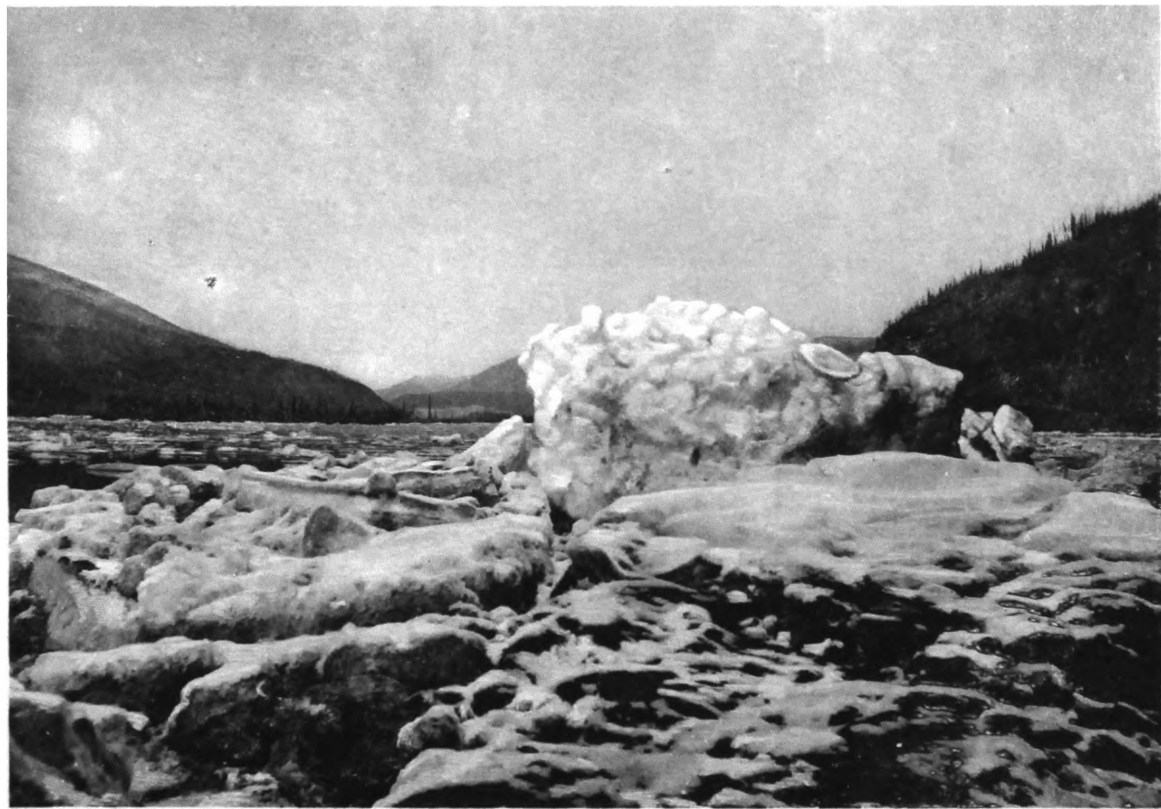

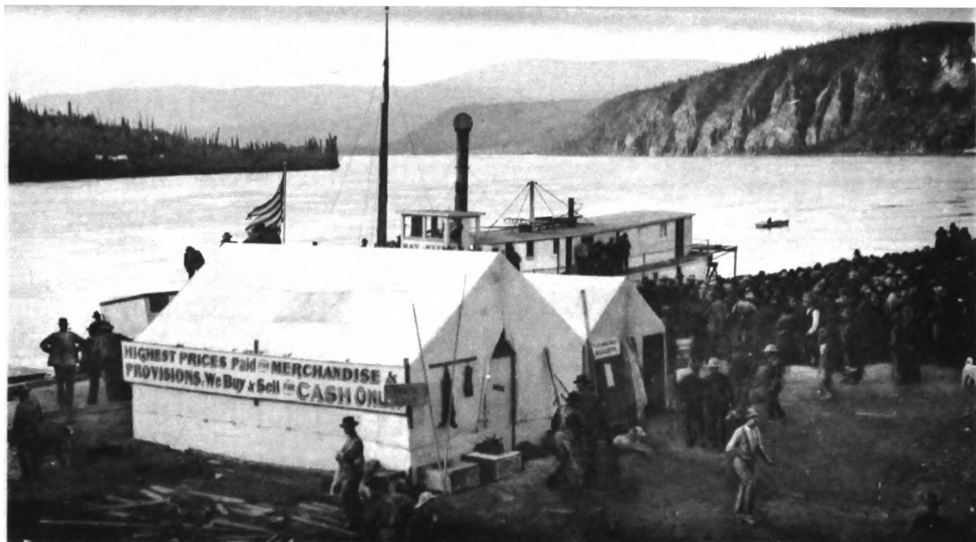

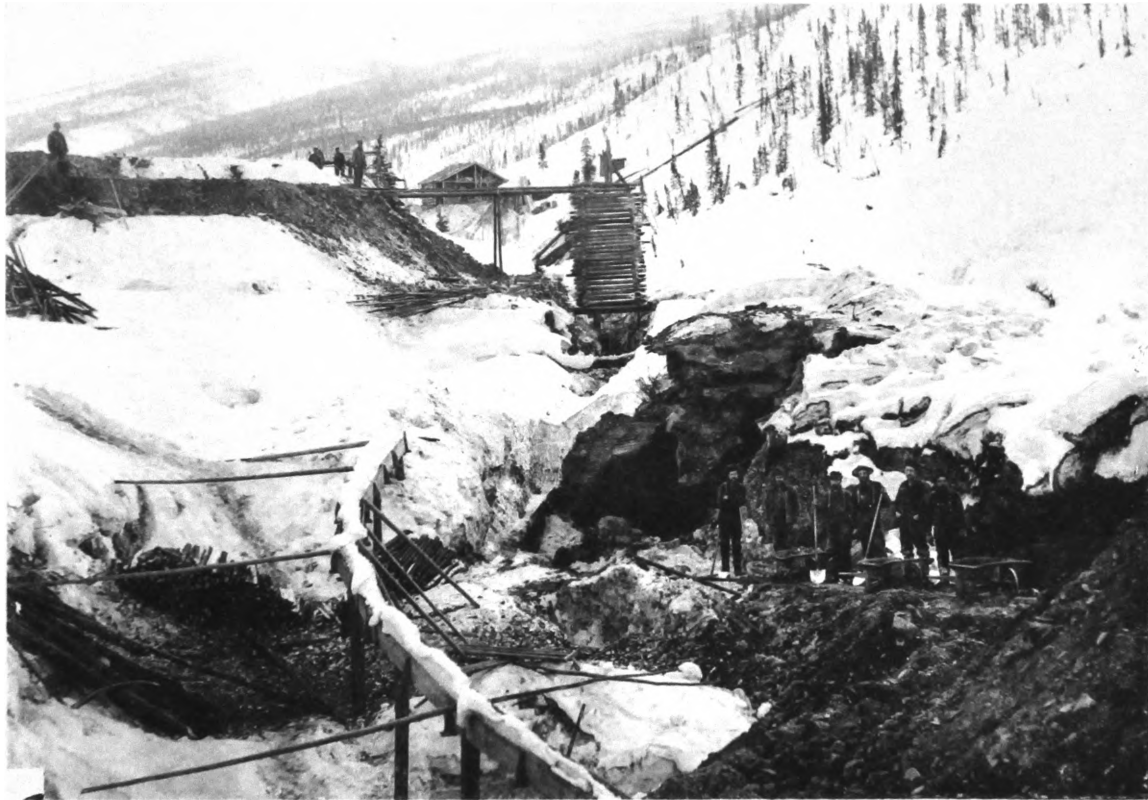

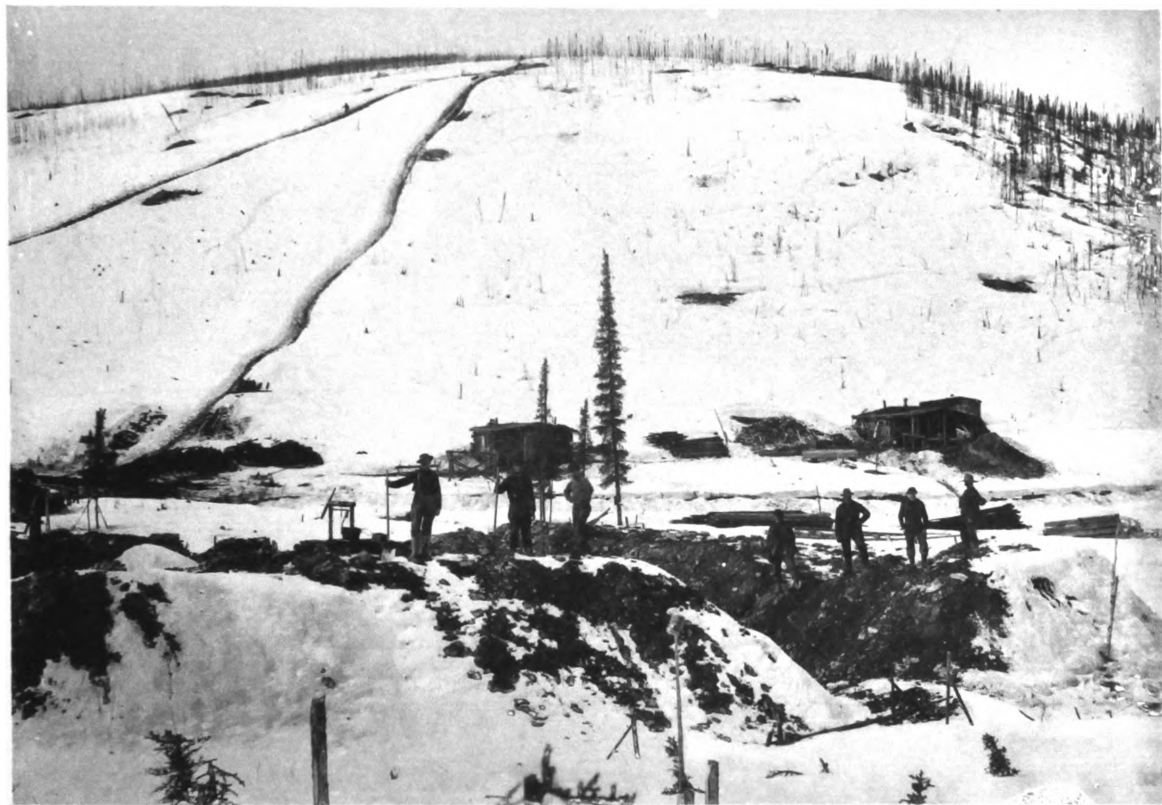


BERRY'S CLAIM, SHOWING THE FORKS OF EL DorADO AND BONANZA.

IS WORKED IN THE SUMMER MONTHS.

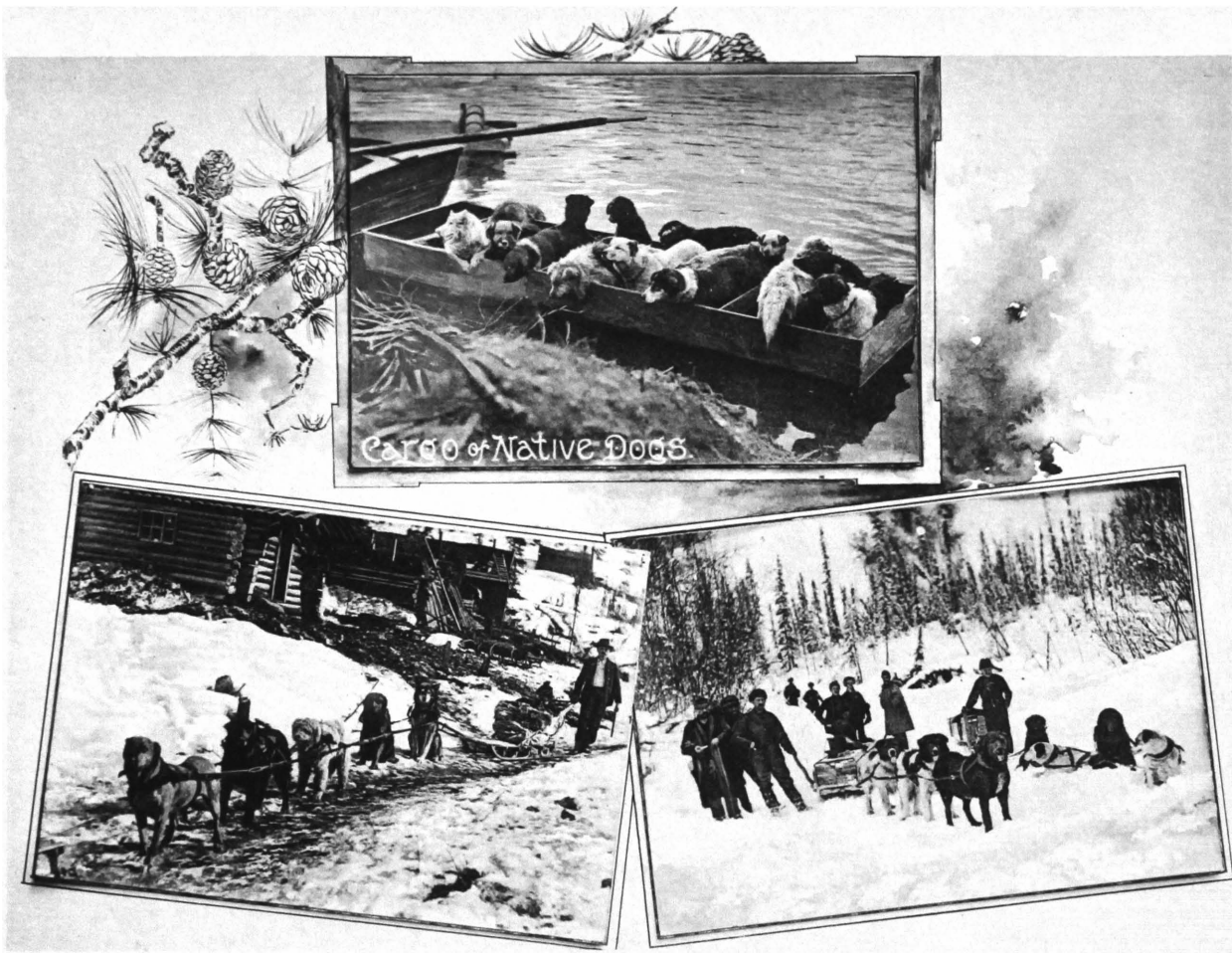

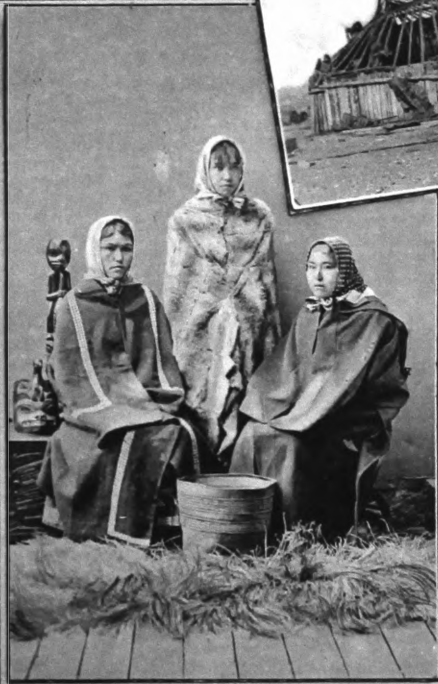

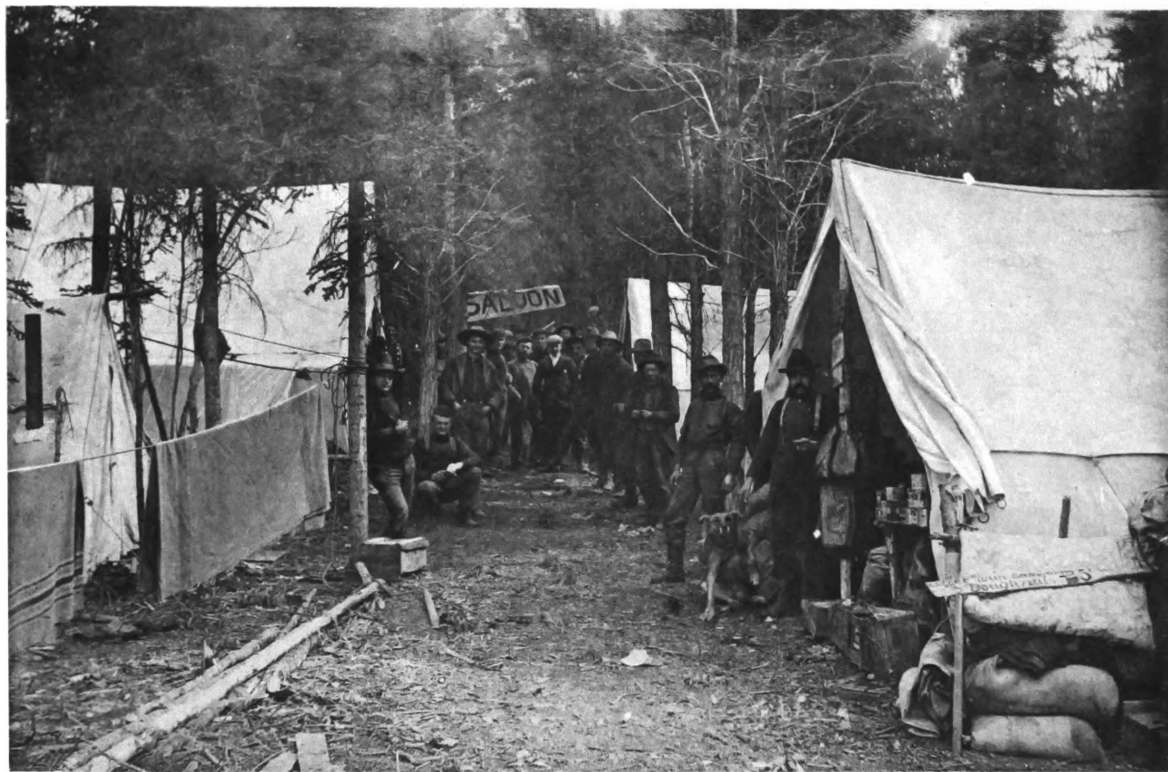
