Her first clinic visit to Atlin was in early January, and the next clinic dates are February 23rd and March 23rd. Priority for appointments is given to returning patients, though there is one slot available for a new patient on Feb 23rd, and two slots available on March 23rd. Initial appointments are 60mins and include a full medical review. Clinic days are held at the Pew.

Dr Jocelyn's clinical focus is women's health - including hormone balancing, fertility/pregnancy, thyroid/adrenal function, weight loss and digestive function, though she is comfortable treating a range of conditions and patients. As a BC-licensed ND with primary care rights, Dr Jocelyn is licensed to provide acupuncture, spinal manipulations, herbal medicine, IV nutrients, and nutrition/supplement advice, along with having full lab-rights and prescription rights in BC. Dr Jocelyn's services are not covered by MSP but are covered under extended health plans.
