The wild flowers of Alaska and British Columbia have not been labelled by a botanist, but many are easily akin to the wild flowers of Canada, and for grace, beauty and coloring would do credit to any country. CLIMATE

The Yukon is a more desirable winter climate than Minnesota. The thermometer ranges from zero to 10 below; at times it is down to 30 and 40, but for a very short time. The absence of winter tempers the cold. In summer it will be one of the greatest tourist countries—beautiful climate, beautiful flowers, beautiful scenery, fine fishing and hunting. Yet it is a most favored land from the head of the lakes to Dawson; romantic, exhilarating and wonderful through July, August and September. The country is good, the mines are better. While in the past the trip was one of difficulties, they are fast passing away. With the completion of the Pacific & Arctic Railway to Caribou Crossing early next season it will be made accessible to the miner and tourist, for there is no question but the richness and beauty of the Yukon basin will then become a by-word in America.

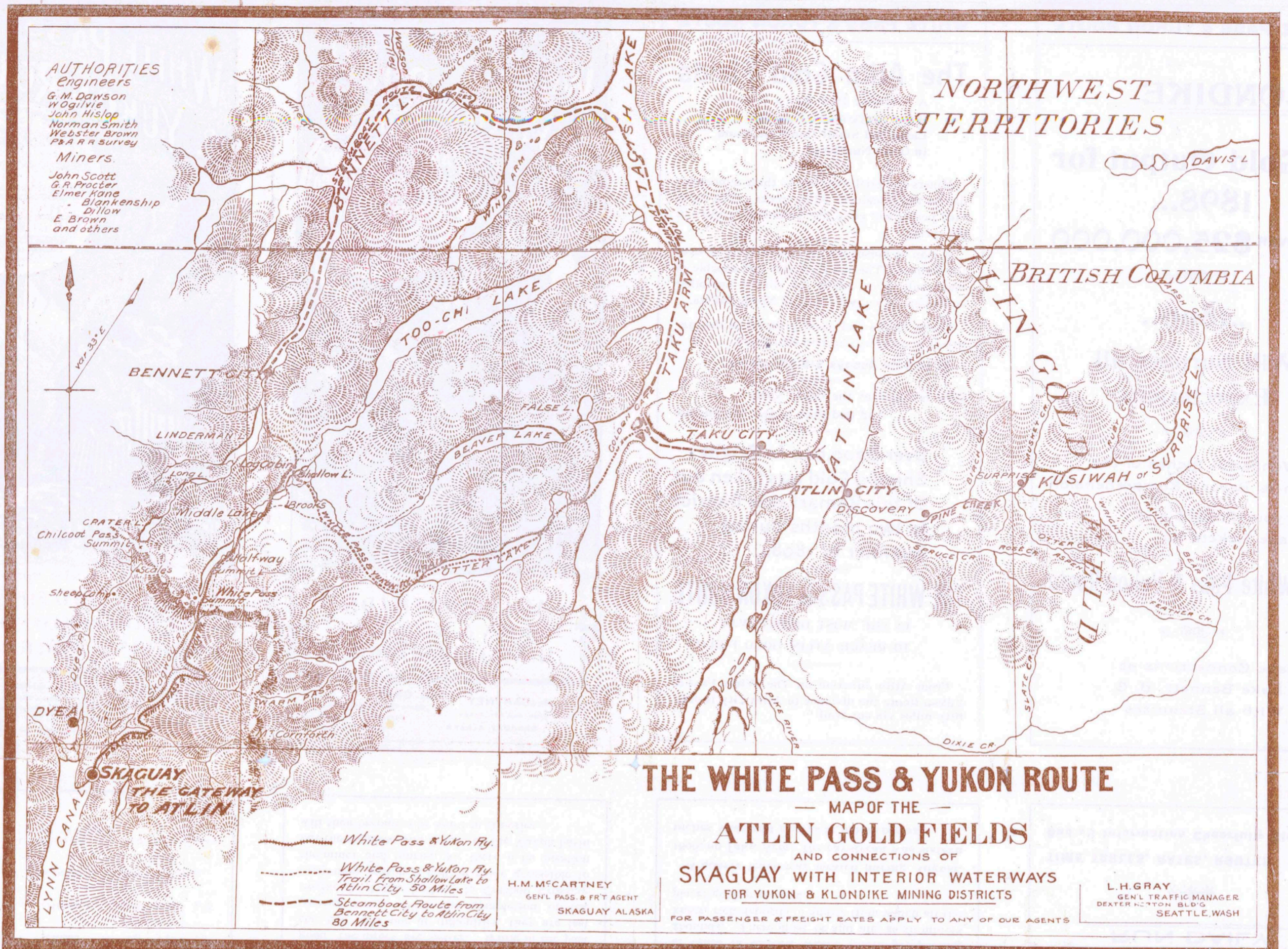
