I have the honour to submit the Financial Report of the Yukon Consolidated Revenue Fund of the Yukon Territory for the fiscal year ending March 31st, 1919.

We began the year with a credit balance of \$6,926.22. The revenue for the past fiscal year exceeded the estimate by \$6,441.20. Liquor Licenses exceeded the estimate by \$6,620.00. Local Taxation and Sundry Revenue, by \$733.97, and Poll Tax collections by \$32.00. The amount received from Liquor Permits was short of the estimate by \$944.77.

The Dominion Government reduced the grant to the Territory for local purposes by \$50,000.00 and the grant for roads was reduced by \$50,000.00, a total reduction of \$100,000.00 or grant of fifty per cent. less than the year previous.

Due to the fact that our grants were so largely reduced a poll tax was imposed upon the residents of the Territory and the sum of \$16,000.00 was placed in the estimates. Collections of poll tax amounted to \$16,032.00 at a net cost for collection of slightly over four per cent.

The expenditures were kept within the appropriations except in the following instances, viz.: Indemnity and Travelling Expenses, Yukon Council, by the amount of \$84.50, caused by three members being delayed on the overland trail during the breakup of the river. Dawson School was overexpended on account of fuel purchase. Whitehorse School was overexpended for Janitor Service \$600.00, which amount through oversight was not placed in the estimates, and also on account of fuel purchase. Public Health—this item was largely overexpended on account of the Territory having to pay one-half of the expenses in connection with quarantine against Spanish influenza at Skagway, Alaska, and for purchase of serum, also because of the fact that there were an unusual number of indigents who had to be taken care of in the Territory. The vote to the City of Dawson from Liquor Licenses was overexpended by \$4,200.00, which amount the Council authorized to be paid to the City of Dawson as per resolution of May 6th, 1918, (see pages 43-44 Journals 1918). The Territorial Assay office was overexpended by \$36.39 for maintenance and repairs. Roads, Bridges and Public Works was overexpended by \$7,875.23. At an informal meeting of six members of the Council and the Gold Commissioner it was décided to advance the sum of \$5,000.00 to assist in the construction of a read which was a necessary work in connection with the development of quartz mining property at Lookout Mountain, in the Mayo District. The sum of \$3,500.00 was paid towards the construction of this road and the balance; \$1,500.00, is to be voted out of this year's appropriations. The road was built by the mine owners at a cost of upwards of \$10,000.00 for seven miles. The balance of the overexpenditure, \$4,375.23, was principally expended on the maintenance of winter roads in the Territory.
